

TO ACCESS THE SHUTTLE TRACKER USING YOUR MOBILE DEVICE:

1. On most phones, pressing the "Globe" button (also known as Operator Key as referenced in your phone user manual) will launch the UC Mobile home page. If your phone does not have this button, directing your phone browser to <http://wap.gocbw.com> will launch the UC Mobile home page. If you have the option on your phone, you can set this as your normal home page.

Your screen should look similar to this (depending on your mobile device).

Note: Motorola browsers do not display a drop down menu. They simply provide the list of choices and you must scroll through and select your route. An asterisk denotes your selection.

3. To **select a route** from the Drop down menu, select the Shuttle route (highlight), and Choose Your screen should look similar to this:

4. To **select a Shuttle stop** > from the drop down menu, select the Shuttle stop (highlight), and Choose . Your screen will display the next three (3) LIVE estimated time of arrival (ETA) for the selected route and stop as follows:

Route: Bearcat Expr

Stop: Eden Front

ETA: 3 - 5 minutes

ETA: 7 - 9 minutes

ETA: 16 - 18 minutes

5. To **update ETA(s)** for the displayed route, click the button, this will pull the latest ETA(s) for the stop you are currently viewing stop results for.
6. To choose a **new Shuttle stop**, from the drop down menu (on the same screen as above), highlight a new Shuttle stop, and Choose .
7. To **select a new Route**, click the button, and repeat steps 2 and 3.
8. To **add to Favorites**, click the button from the stop results page.
 - The **Add to Favorites** does not work on some of the lower end phones and is not shown as an option (The Nokia free phone is an example).
9. To **access Favorites** from the stops result page, choose button. This brings you to the 1st screen. Choose the 'My Favorites' link.

NOTE: Rather than hitting the "back" key to get to the beginning of the application, it is faster to click the button.

TO ACCESS *UC FROM YOUR MOBILE PHONE

From the key pad on your phone, Call *UC, or *82 to be directly connected to Campus Security.
