Network Change Summary:		
Cincinnati Bell Telephone ("CBT") will be replacing central office based copper/metallic cable infrastructure in the Bethel, Ohio (BETHOHBE) wire center with fiber optic cable systems and remote Digital Loop Carrier architectures.		
Description of type of changes planned:		
CBT is migrating from a copper to a fiber infrastructure. With this migration, copper/metallic facilities originating in the BETHOHBE central office will be retired from service and removed. Customers will be transitioned to fiber based services and remote Digital Loop Carrier systems. The changes will affect the following areas (Serving Area Cabinets or Fiber Serving Areas):

Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact of the Planned Changes:

After the planned network changes are implemented, loops comprised entirely of copper will not be available between the above referenced central office and customer premises in the wire center. In serving areas fed by fiber facilities to the customer premise, no copper facilities will remain for service. Copper distribution and drop facilities will remain in select serving areas within the wire center where remote Digital Loop Carrier Systems are being deployed. Under both architectures, where feasible, vacated copper facilities will be physically removed and those that cannot be removed will be retired in place and no longer be maintained. Customer services will be transferred to the new infrastructure being placed. To the extent required by applicable agreements and federal law, CBT will offer to requesting carriers a 64kbps voice grade channel over fiber loops that have been deployed where copper was retired. Currently there are no competitive carrier circuits located in the Bethel, Ohio wire center.
